MS. MILLER: The qualifications for the
Certified Florida Appraiser and Certified Florida
Evaluator professional designations include at

least two years of experience with a Florida property appraiser's or tax collector's office or the Florida Department of Revenue, at least 120 hours of approved education, and current employment with a Florida county property appraiser's or tax collector's office or the Florida Department of Revenue. The Certified Florida Appraiser designation is reserved for the county official.

The qualifications for the Certified

Cadastralist of Florida include at least two years
of experience with a Florida property appraiser's
office or the Florida Department of Revenue, at
least 150 hours of approved education, and current
employment with a Florida property appraiser's
office or the Florida Department of Revenue.

MR. BLACKBURN: Thank you, Meghan.
