Dear Ms. Jackson:

In accordance with section 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., this letter serves as notification to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee that the referenced rule has not been substantively changed from the proposed rule amendment published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on October 10, 2025 (Vol. 51, No. 198, pp. 3883-3884).

Technical non-substantive changes were made to Rule 12-18.004, F.A.C., via a Notice of Correction published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on November 6, 2025 (Vol. 51, No. 217, p. 4371).

The Department reviewed the proposed rule listed above and determined that the proposed rule likely will not have an adverse impact on small businesses, small counties, or small cities, and it is not likely to have an increased regulatory cost in excess of \$200,000 within one year. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rule. The rule does not require ratification by the Legislature pursuant to Section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department of Revenue will file the proposed rule amendment for certification with the Department of State on December 2, 2025, for an effective date of December 22, 2025. This rule is filed not more than 90 days after the notice.
