12E-1.037, F.A.C. – Notification to Withhold Support from Reemployment Assistance

Dear Ms. Jackson:

In accordance with section 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., this letter serves as notification to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee that the referenced rule has not changed from publication of the Notice of Proposed Rule in the *Florida Administrative Register* on June 25, 2025 (Vol. 51, No. 123, pp. 2293-2294). The notice provided that, if requested in writing, a rule hearing would be scheduled. No request was received, and no hearing was held.

The Department reviewed the proposed rules listed above and determined that the proposed rules likely will not have an adverse impact on small business, small counties, or small cities, and are not likely to have an increased regulatory cost in excess of \$200,000 within one year. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rules. The rules do not require ratification by the Legislature pursuant to Section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department requests that the Committee file its certification with the Bureau of Administrative Code on August 15, 2025. With your approval, the Department will file the proposed rules for final adoption on August 15, 2025, for an effective date of September 4, 2025.
